It is the current global language of commerce, education and science. The rise of English as a global language is an intensely interesting historical phenomena that has implications for its practical usage and pedagogy in Taiwan. In this course, we will consider English in relation to its past, present and future. We will seek to understand the following questions: Why do we learn English? What can we hope to profit from it? What becomes of people who learn English? What really motivates people to learn English? How is English transformed by people who speak in widely differing locations? By answering these questions and others, students will develop a broad basis necessary for research in TESOL.
