	<p>課程敘述: 這門課設計來增進學生聽說讀寫的能力並由課堂上提供的學習資源加強他們的英文學習經驗。課程的教材以及教科書提供多樣的主題擴展學生相關知識並且使學生具有真實生活的英文。格列佛遊記這本讀本用來培養學生的閱讀技巧,對於內容的理解力以及閱讀能力的訓練並增加學生對於此語言的興趣。其他課堂補充教材用以激勵學生連結課堂學習到的英語到日常生活的語言使用。在這堂課中,學生會被引導討論教師提出的議題,並根據課堂教材的主題報告來訓練學生的語言技巧如批判思考的能力以及口語表達。學生也會被要求練習寫作來訓練其英文寫作能力。這門課目的在於增進學生的英文能力以及引導學生成功的學習方式來達到更高階的英文能力。</p> <p>教學方式: 授課,小組討論以及小組報告</p> <p>課堂要求: 此門課要求學生規律的出席,學生也被鼓勵主動參與課堂活動。課堂參與佔期末總成績5%。每位學生被要求參與所有小考,期中及期末考並完成所有作業以及讀本摘要。所有考試都沒有提供補考</p>		<p>Course description: This course is designed to advance participants' four skills on English reading, listening, speaking and writing and to strengthen their English learning experiences with resources provided in class. Class materials and the textbook offer diverse daily topics to broaden participants' knowledge of the world and gear them with real life English. The reader Gulliver's Travels is assigned to develop participants' reading skills, comprehension of the contents and reading proficiency, and to increase their interests. Other supplementary materials will be provided to motivate participants to link class materials to real life language use. In this course, participants will be instructed to discuss issues brought up by the instructor and present on various topics based on class materials so as to practice their language skills in different aspects such as critical thinking as well as oral expressions. Participants will be given writing tasks to develop their writing skills. The integrated instruction of English four skills in this course aims at improving participants' English competence and directing them to successful English learning methods to achieve higher English proficiency.</p> <p>Teaching mode: Lecture, group discussion, and group presentation</p>
