The major international economic and commercial organizations as well as the fundamental factors which have great influence in the sphere of the international economy and trade are the focal points of this course. Success in this course relies upon the students' active participation, both in and outside of the classroom. Students will form groups to present one of the assigned topics to the class. The presentations will be followed by discussions. The assigned topics include the WTO, the IMF, direct investments, and MNC. Students are supposed to do research before the class discussion and collect material on the selected topic. Upon successful completion of this course, the student will have a basic understanding of international business.</p>
